Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$4,800,000 in funding for the **City of Dallas Abrams Road Infrastructure Improvements** project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Dallas, located at 1500 Marilla St., Dallas, TX 75201. The funding would be used for comprehensive corridor improvements along 3.3 miles of Abrams Road from Richmond Avenue to Northwest Highway, including traffic signal modernization, ADA-compliant sidewalks, pedestrian crossings, median and streetscape enhancements, intersection redesign, potential lane reconfiguration, and bicycle safety improvements to reduce crashes, improve accessibility, and support neighborhood-serving commercial activity.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it directly addresses roadway safety, accessibility, and economic vitality. Improvements will reduce crash risk for pedestrians and cyclists, enhance access to local businesses, and support corridor revitalization.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in 23 USC 133.
