Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$3,000,000 in funding for the **City of Dallas Midway Road Safety Improvements** project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Dallas, located at 1500 Marilla St., Dallas, TX 75201. The funding would be used to support construction activities along Midway Road between Trinity Mills Road and the President George Bush Turnpike in Far North Dallas, including installation of crash barriers, sidewalk and curb improvements, traffic signal upgrades, lighting improvements, and signage upgrades.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this corridor connects residential neighborhoods to major regional routes, including the President George Bush Turnpike. Midway Road has been identified as part of the City of Dallas High Injury Network, a small percentage of streets where the majority of severe crashes occur. This project's improvements will reduce crash risk, protect nearby homes, and improve safety for both drivers and pedestrians.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in 23 USC 133.
