I am requesting \$600,000 in funding for the **Lakewood Park Pedestrian Bridge & Accessibility** project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Dallas, located at 1500 Marilla Street, Dallas, TX 75201. The funding would be used to construct a new pedestrian bridge and enhance ADA accessibility in the associated parking lot.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this bridge will connect multi-use pathways on either side of a creek, and improve mobility options for residents.
